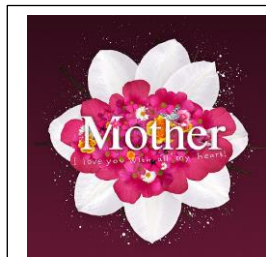


Library
